

## Code of Conduct: for Covid-19

**During the Covid-19 pandemic we have had to put further measures into place to keep members, parents / guardians, & staff safe while attending Generation Gymnastics.**

- Parents will not be able to enter the gym(including the waiting area) at either drop off or pick up. (with the expectation of pre school classes where one parents / carer per child only can come in)
- A member of staff will collect gymnasts from car park at the start of lesson and take children to the gym car park at the end of their lesson for parents to collect, (due to health and safety all parents must come into the gym car park to collect their children, we can not allow children to leave the gym car park unattended unless previously notified us in writing).
- All gymnasts will have temperature checks prior to entering the building. Anyone with a high temperature (38 degrees or more) will be sent home.
- All gymnasts must arrive on time dressed ready for their lesson. This should be in a clean leotard and shorts / clean clothing & socks (we will not be able to lend any socks out).
- No changing facilities will be available for use (outside portacabin will be closed).
- Long hair must be tied back, ideally in a bun or two plates. (Staff will not be able to assist with putting hair up before or during a class)
- All jewellery must be removed before coming to class, if not the child will not be able to join the class (staff will be unable to remove ear rings)
- All participants & staff will need to bring their own named water bottle (drinking water will not be supplied)
- Staff & participants only, to use the gym toilets one at a time (toilets will be cleaned daily before and after gymnastics classes).
- All participants will be grouped and kept within the same group for the term booking.
- All participants and coaches will need to keep social distancing with government guidelines (other than gymnasts & coaches opted in to phased return to coach contact & parenter work).
- We will be implementing British gymnastics phased return to coach contact (gymnasts who this may effect will receive an opt in agreement)
- Display squad will be able to return to partner work in line with British gymnastics guidelines (gymnast who this may effect will receive an opt in agreement)
- We will have hand sanitiser which everyone will need to use before lesson & between apparatus.
- Large equipment will be cleaned daily, smaller personal items will be cleaned between use.
- We will have cleaning checklists to be signed off for all areas and equipment.
- If the participant or anyone in their household is classed as vulnerable we would advise you not to return until the government says it is safe to do so.
- If the participant or anyone in their household shows Covid 19 symptoms or tests positive within 2 days of attending a class they must inform the club immediately.
- If the participant or anyone in your household has any of the covid-19 symptoms you will not be able to attend the club until at least 10 days after (providing you no longer have symptoms).
- Anyone not abiding by the covid rules will be made to sit out, we will advise parents at the end of the lesson. If this happens again they may be asked to leave the club.
